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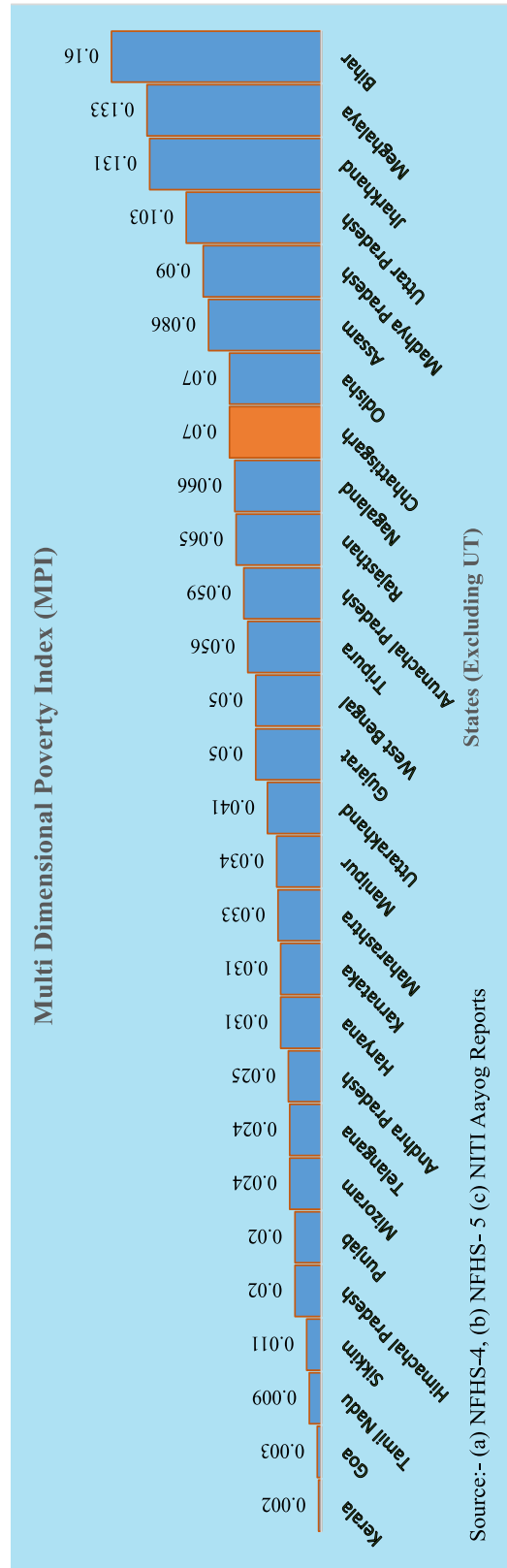
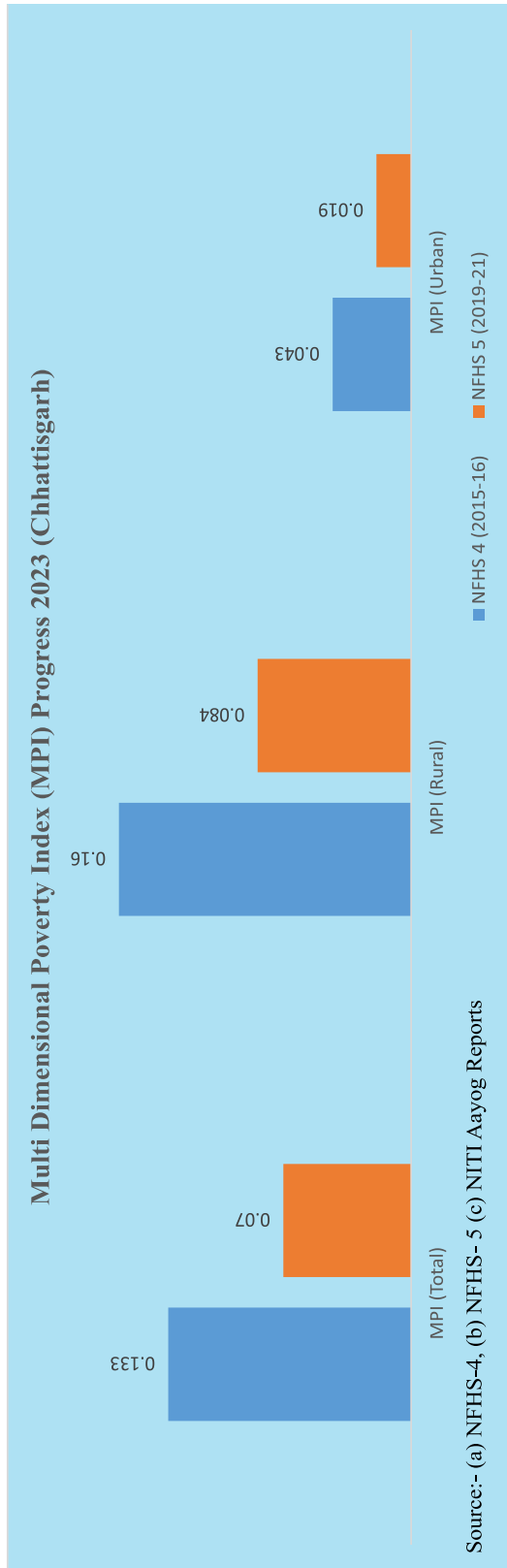

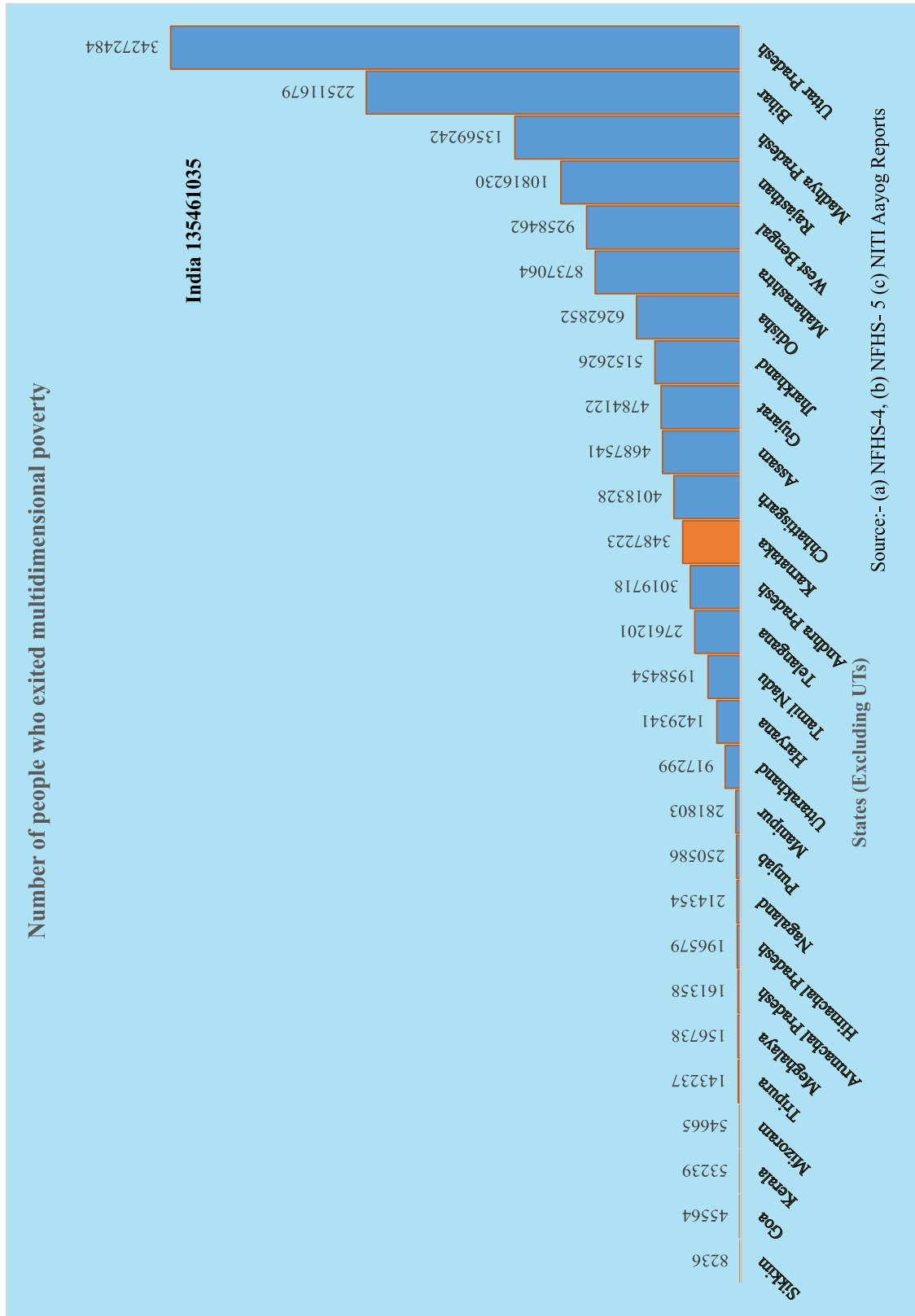
### मुख्य बिन्दु

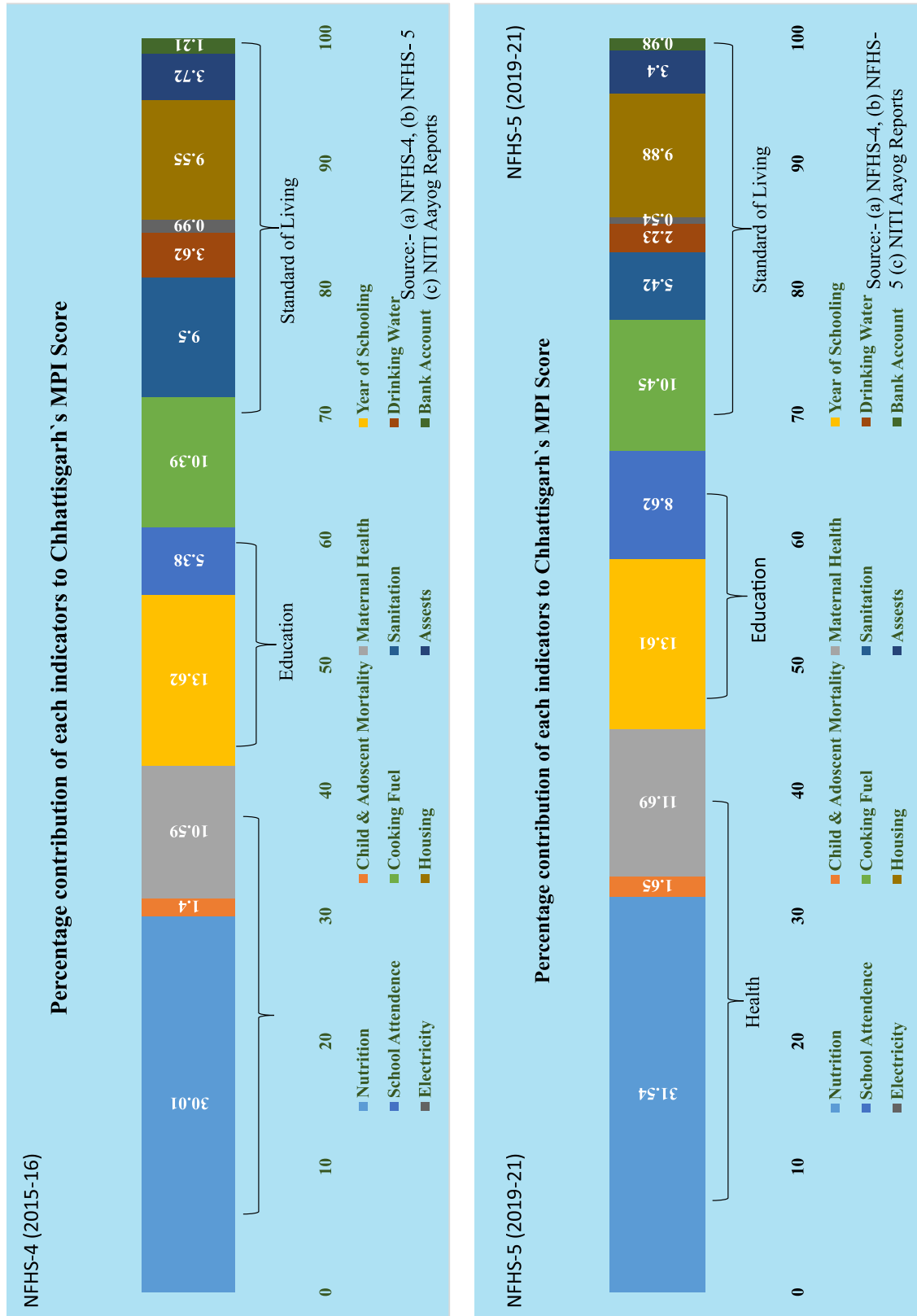
- वर्ष 2015–16 से 2019–21 में छत्तीसगढ़ एमपीआई क्रमशः 0.133 से 0.70 | अर्थात् 2015–16 की तुलना में 2019–21 में छत्तीसगढ़ राज्य में सुधार हुआ है।
- 2015–16 में एनएफएचएस–4 नारायणपुर में उच्चतम एमपीआई 0.255 थी, जबकि 2019–21 में एनएफएचएस–5 में 0.183 एमपीआई थी, जो दर्शाता है कि छत्तीसगढ़ के दूरदराज के इलाकों में बुनियादी ढांचागत सुविधाओं का प्रावधान बढ़ रहा है।
- 2019–21 में, एनएफएचएस–5 दुर्ग में न्यूनतम एमपीआई (0.14) और बीजापुर में उच्चतम एमपीआई (0.262) है।
- एनएफएचएस–4, 2015–16 और एनएफएचएस–2019–21 की तुलना में, यह स्पष्ट है कि सभी जिलों ने 2015–16 से 2019–21 तक अपने बहुआयामी गरीबी स्कोर में सुधार किया है, जो छत्तीसगढ़ के लिए एक अच्छा संकेत है कि राज्य साल–दर–साल धीरे–धीरे विकसित हो रहा है।
- भारत के कुल 500 आंकाक्षी विकासखण्डों में छत्तीसगढ़ के 20 आंकाक्षी विकासखण्ड हैं। छत्तीसगढ़ के इन 20 विकासखण्डों में नारायणपुर विकासखण्ड छत्तीसगढ़ में प्रथम रैंक तथा 20वें स्थान पर कोयलीबेड़ा विकासखण्ड है।

- National Commission On Population Ministry Of Health & Family Welfare, GoI के अनुसार 01 मार्च, 2024 की स्थिति में छत्तीसगढ़ की कुल कार्यशील जनसंख्या प्रतिशत 48.72 है। पुरुष कार्यशील जनसंख्या प्रतिशत 57.97 तथा महिला कार्यशील जनसंख्या प्रतिशत 39.40 है।
